WELLINGTON PARK COMMUNITY LEAGUE COVID-19 RE-ENTRY

COVID-19 remains a serious health threat, especially for older adults, people with underlying health conditions, and people with compromised immune systems. In preparing to re-open the Community League, we are faced with the constant challenges of COVID-19. Together, the community and the residents will do our utmost to mitigate risks to allow for effective operations as conditions allow.

The emphasis during the re-entry remains the protection of volunteers, community members and those who will be renting the Community Hall.

As we move forward, we must embrace the "New Normal" the in-house programming, community membership drives, community functions and hall rentals; the Wellington Park Community League will provide guidance for leaders to comply with provincial health and community directives.

As directed by the Chief Medical Officer of Health, community leagues should seek to employ risk mitigation protocols when appropriate physical distance cannot be achieved. These protocols and strategies may include the use of personal protective equipment (PPE), heightened cleaning, physical barriers, or other strategies as deemed appropriate to ensure the safety of the public.

Wellington Park Community League will ensure:

- Administrative Controls • Volunteers and Screening: Before each program, the leader must assess themselves for symptoms of COVID-19.

Onsite – safe practices: Physical Distancing, Hygiene Etiquette

- Hand sanitation stations will be available at the entrance to the hall and in the main area. Hand wash stations are in the bathrooms.

- Mask are mandatory to be worn inside the community hall.

Cleaning & Disinfecting

- Cleaning for the Main Community Hall and the Small Hall will be done directly before a group enters the space and after the group exits the space.
- Additional enhanced cleaning will be done with disinfectant on high traffic areas such as door handles, counter tops, light switches, remote controls and keypads.

In the event of a known COVID-19 exposure in our Community League or a spike in cases in Alberta, Wellington Park Community League will shut down league programming or events with little or no notice.

The City of Edmonton has proposed four supportive housing projects throughout the city as part of its plan to address homelessness. Collectively, these four sites would provide new housing for 150 people.

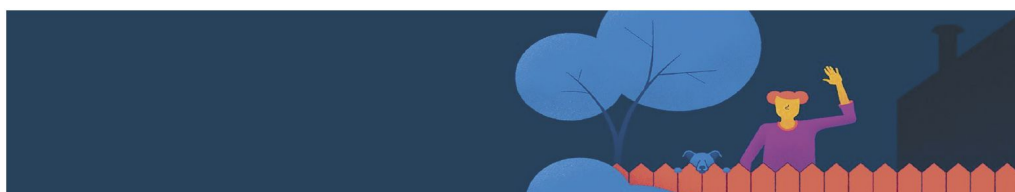
